



Inn and Spa at Loretto Fact Sheet

THE PERSPECTIVE

Celebrating its 400th anniversary and steeped in Native American, Spanish and Western cultures, Santa Fe was recently noted as one of the nation's most historically interesting cities. Natural beauty and a soulful landscape are intrinsic to its character, contributing to its standing as the second largest art market in the U.S. Embracing its diversity and its heritage as the oldest Capital city in the United States, Santa Fe is brimming with extraordinary entertainment, an exquisite dining scene and endless recreational activities. The Inn and Spa at Loretto is a fixture in the Santa Fe community. Originally built on the site of the Sister's of Loretto girls' school and sharing grounds with the famed Loretto Chapel, the Inn pulsates with the essence of Santa Fe.

THE LOCATION

Surrounded by thousands of acres of pristine wilderness, the Sangre de Cristo Mountains and nestled in the heart of Santa Fe, the Inn and Spa at Loretto sits at the end of the historical Santa Fe Trail and is one of the most photographed buildings in the state. The Inn is centrally located within walking distance to Canyon Road's "Artists' Row", the Plaza and the Palace of the Governors, Georgia O'Keeffe Museum, boutiques, shops and restaurants.

THE DESIGN

The Inn and Spa at Loretto embodies the culture of the region, utilizing adobe-style architecture and reflecting the true spirit and history of Santa Fe. A palette adorned with the work of local artisans, completes the soulfully elegant retreat.

134 fully appointed guest rooms, including five specialty suites (ranging from 300 to 700 square feet) and a 2,800-square-foot, two story presidential suites, feature an upscale design. Most rooms have balconies access with views of the Sangre de Cristo Mountains, Saint Francis Cathedral and Loretto Chapel.

SPA SERVICES

The Spa at Loretto features six spa suites including a wet room with Vichy shower designed to pamper individuals and couples with massages, facials, manicures, pedicures, wraps and other unique signature treatments. The Inn's warm tones reach through the spa, which is adorned with honey-stained wood floors made of eastern white pine, cream and terracotta diamond faux finished adobe walls and beaded amber sconces. A candlelit fireplace and traditional banco seats create an inviting reception area. Spa suites carry the same warm color hues and natural textures and feature beautifully carved cabinetry. Porcelain and copper tubs and original hand-woven accent fabrics enhance the mystique of the Spa at Loretto.
